Open Enrollment for LATE Enrollment Period (outside the early enrollment window)

While elementary schools use grade level, secondary schools use similar classes to determine threshold. Secondary schools may appear to have space available, when in fact they do not. An example would be when all 10th grade English classes are full but some math or social studies classes are not. A similar situation may occur when 7th grade TLC rotations are over-crowded, but English or math appear to have space available.
